


The Original BOYS TOWN

Old Market


Enjoy a guided driving tour of Omaha's past, present and future. A professional guide will join your group for an overview of Omaha's top points of interest. Tour highlights include; the historic Old Market Entertainment District with its cobblestone streets and unique boutiques; Lewis & Clark Landing, the historic spot where the exploring duo landed; the historic Gold

Coast District, listed on the National Register of Historic Places; a 1903 Scottish Castle; Blackstone Hotel, the birthplace of the Reuben sandwich; St. Cecilia Cathedral; TD Ameritrade Park Omaha, home of the annual NCAA Men's College World Series; Omaha Community Playhouse, the theater where actor Henry

Fonda started his acting career; and Hollywood Candy, filled wall-to-wall with retro candy. Groups will also have an opportunity to experience **Pioneer Courage Park**. The park features more than 100 larger-than-life sized bronze sculptures that tell the story of the pioneer's westward journey
